Support	Enhancement Roadmap	Optimization pipeline, support model and continuous improvement

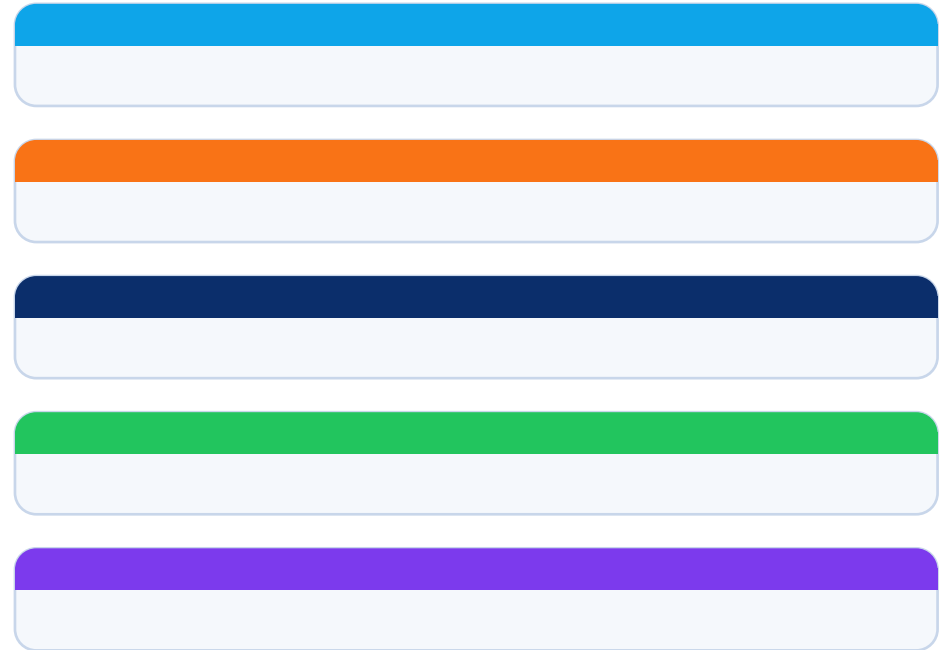
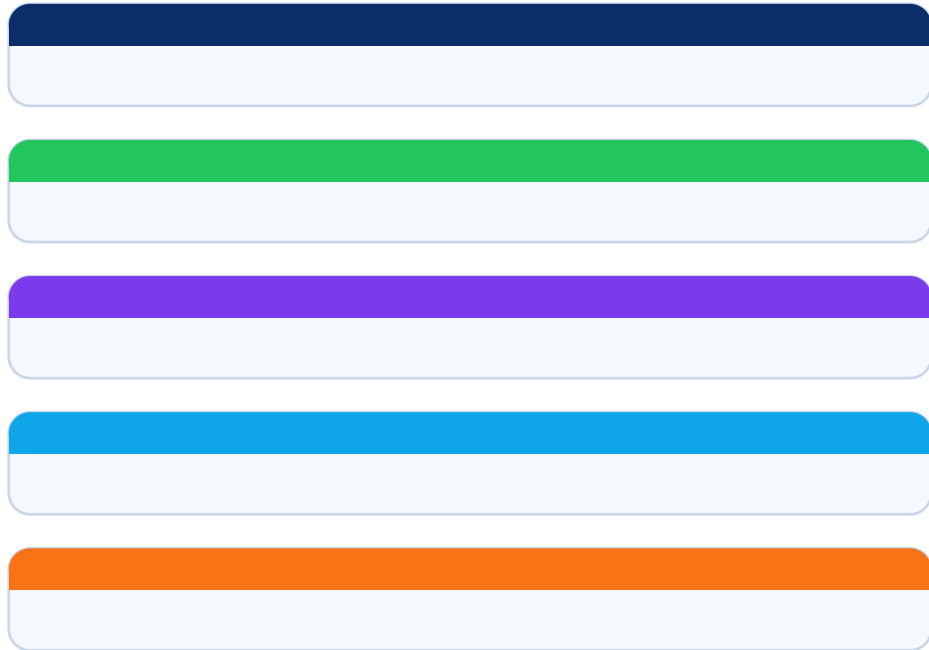


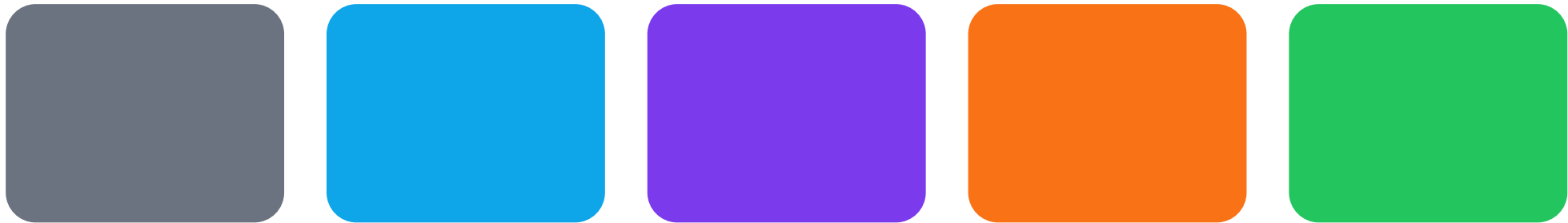
Typical adoption indicators include training completion, active users, feature utilization, support tickets, user confidence, department usage and role-based process compliance.
